


Discussion Questions


Session 1 – Part One (pxvii-47)

- 6) How do you connect with the idea of heart preparation for revival?




Discussion Questions Session 2 – Part Two (p49-96)

- 5) Have you been baptised with the Holy Spirit?




Discussion Questions Session 3 – Part Three (p99-126)

- 7) What does holiness mean to you?




Discussion Questions Session 4 – Part Three (p127-149)
