

Prophetic words shared throughout 2025 for St Mary's

I thought I should just share a picture I had during the worship at church on Sunday morning.

I saw a golden clock. I sensed that God was saying 'its time'. He is about to do something, but I really sensed that we mustn't get in the way.

I felt I had to 'physically' move to one side as a response during the worship on Sunday, so that I wouldn't be in the Lord's way.

It was similar to 'staying low' that you have spoken about.

I felt it was for me, but also for everyone.

I hope it's helpful.

After the worship service last night, I had a picture/a sense that there was a great wave waiting to come upon us. God's glory that we have been praying for. But it was held there, giving us time to prepare and to count the cost.

I sensed that when the wave of God's glory comes it will be glorious, but God is reminding us that it will also be 'uncomfortable'.

It will mean laying down our lives for the Kingdom. It will mean God showing us his heart for people in this broken world and that can be painful. It might mean nights in Intercession as the Spirit of God prompts us. It might mean three extra unplanned hours of worship after the church service instead of going home for dinner, just because God desires it. It will mean laying down our plans for our own lives and going out perhaps prayer walking and witnessing as we follow the Holy Spirit instead of whatever we had planned for that day.

It's that sense that God's glory will come upon us, but it will be challenging and uncomfortable and the wave is just pausing so we can be sure we are ready for it.

I thought of that verse in Romans 8 v 17 and 18 that says: '...if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may share in his glory.'

This morning I also saw a picture of a field of long grass or wheat and it was being separated right down the middle and I sensed it was a separation in the church as a whole (world wide church not just ours). On one side it was those ready and seeking for God's glory and kingdom and the other side was those who are not yet ready, those who are not yet matured or those who are still caught up in the things of the world. I sensed God was being so patient and loving and waiting for those who were not yet ready.

That was all.

I'm praying that I will be both ready and willing when the wave comes!

As I was worshipping this morning I had a picture and this verse.

Hebrews 4:16

Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

I saw a huge throne on the chancel steps of St Mary's. It was so big I couldn't really see the beginning or end of it. It was white and there was a rushing sound of worship surrounding the throne and voices were singing worthy is the Lamb.

I felt there was an invitation from the Lord to approach God's throne of grace, to repent, to receive mercy and forgiveness. Nothing is irredeemable. I then felt white hot flames coming from the throne that consumed the church, but it was widespread as I could look up and see the sky. It was fierce and I felt the fear of the Lord. Then there was silence as through the ashes what remained was white, pure, and new growth appeared. There was dew which was like that which rests on new green shoots in a garden. There was immense peace.

I pray that if any of that description is from me, that it will melt away and leave what God might be saying.

I have felt a prophetic word growing in me since our meeting on Monday and I was able to write it down this morning:

This is a word for all who own my name.

The pace is beginning to quicken and it is more urgent that you get yourselves ready.

Stir up your desire for my presence. Seek me above all else and you will find me when you seek me with all your heart.

Fan into flame the gifts I have given you. There are those now young in faith who will overtake those old in the Faith, simply because their hearts want me more and they carry less baggage. Encourage them and follow their example.

Simplify your lives. Get rid of the things and attitudes that hinder and slow you down so that you can keep pace with me. Tear down your idols and return to your First Love. I tell you that those who were concerned not to get ahead of me should, from this time forwards, be concerned to keep up with me.

Purify your hearts and be transformed by the renewing of your minds. I am pouring out new wine and you need new wineskins to contain it.

You have been too concerned with what is not important and have lost impetus like a crowd that is milling around without direction. Fix your eyes on me, open your ears to hear me and start to move with me - I will show you what to do.

Do the things you did at first - seek first my kingdom and my righteousness and I will provide the rest.

I am doing a new thing I am making rivers in the desert, do you not perceive it?

Do you not perceive it?

Have you not sensed it down on your inside?

Have you not felt it in the depths of your spirit?

I am going to do a new thing

Have you not heard that I am moving, are the there not rumours here and there?

I am allowing my living water to trickle before the flood, so that the water can soak into the the dry soil making the ground moist and fertile so that when my flood comes the water will not just run off but will remain and be sustained

I love you

I love your country

I am about to redeem it for myself

So many have turned away from me, both in my church and in the nation.

I have allowed this to happen.

I know that it has been a dry place for a long time and many of you have lost heart

I have not forgotten you

I love you

The time is near when I will turn the trickles into floods

You will see the new thing I am doing in those who have been faithfully pressing on through this dry season

Do you not perceive it?

I just felt I should send you several words that God has given me over time about being ready for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit as I hope it's an encouragement for what Gods put on your heart already about being Revival Ready !

I am coming like a rushing wind, I will loosen up and blow away all that is holding you down, My Holy Spirit is coming too cleanse you. Do not fear this time . Anticipate the excitement that you will feel and embrace what is coming

Buckle up and BE READY ! A tsunami of the Holy Spirit is coming, I have equipped you with life jackets so you will not drown in all I'm doing.

Go and prepare others. They will be frightened if not prepared or understand what it will be like to be in my presence in the fullness of God. I have come to save this world , I have been patient, But the time is coming and the world will see me !

So let me transform you & your situation with my love, so much so that you will hardly recognise yourself or your situation.

Surrender all to me & make yourself ready for what is to come, I am looking for those who have been patiently seeking me for my next move of LOVE

So come because he is worthy of it all

Acts 2 v 2 suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting

Woken with a word preparation .

A room that needs decorating, the wallpaper stripped and holes that need filling and sanding , then possibly plastered for a smooth finish then an undercoat of paint finally ready for the “ Final Coat of paint !! So you are Ready !!

Ready for Revival ! How do we prepare ?

What needs stripping away from us
What deep hurt needs Gods healing and smoothing out

It's not always an easy process but a process that is needed to receive the fullness of God and his freedom, to be able to be ready for what he has for you and wants you to do

We need to be ready and prepared for what the Holy Spirit wants to do

So come to him today and ask him to show you and help you get your room ready. The Holy Spirit is at the door we need to let him in

John 14.26

But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

Over the past few years our Lord has given me a song and/or a scripture for the coming year. Last year the scripture was Ezekiel 37:1-10 The Valley of Dry Bones and the song was Rattle by Elevation Worship

Can you hear those dry bones rattling...

This year our Lord took me back to Ezekiel and as I waded through the numerous visions of the despicable things His people were doing, it reminded me of the state of the Church and people in this country. Ezekiel has a vision in

chapters 40 to 48 of the rebuilding of a new Temple in Jerusalem [yet to be constructed] This spoke to me of Jesus building a new Temple in us and through us. The “water flowing below the threshold of the Temple” in chapter 47:1-2, leading me back to Ezekiel 37:24 One Nation Under One King “Jesus”

Can you hear those dry bones rattling as God rebuilds His temple in us and through us....

BUT up to a couple of weeks ago I hadn't received a song for the year but while I was preparing the songs for it occurred to me that I had been learning to play a song called Egypt by Cory Asbury since June 2024, that suddenly made sense. The reason being is that during our Hope central prayer and fasting day on 11th January the team individually received different parts of prophetic word/picture: “God is a covenant/promise keeping God and He is taking us into the land He has promised us, a land flowing with milk and honey. With the milk representing growth and fertility [new beginnings] and the honey representing God's blessings, love, strength, wisdom, things of great worth in and through Jesus.”

Can you hear those dry bones rattling as God rebuilds His temple in us and through us, as He leads us into a promised land, a land flowing with milk and honey.

We believe that Jesus is promising to lead St Marys out of emotional and spiritual captivity and into a land of milk and honey. With the milk representing growth and fertility [new beginnings] and the honey representing God's blessings, love, strength, wisdom, things of great worth in and through Jesus.”

But in order for this to happen we need to have a fallow season to allow the leaves to fall to the ground representing the stuff that binds us, emotionally, physically and spiritually dropping off us and Jesus is going to use these leaves to produce fertiliser for new growth and that this is a time where He will plant the seeds in this newly prepared soil. So that the Holy Spirit “water flowing below the threshold of the temple in Ezekiel” can water the newly fertilised and prepared ground producing healthy new growth and freedom.

Or in another way a fallow season that will allow those in captivity and slavery to be led out of their Egypt and into their promised land. To be who God has created them to be.

Fallow – “farmland ploughed but left for a period without being sown in order to restore its fertility” So we can find the pearl of great worth in the field we have purchased.

We don’t know how this looks but it could be a structured stripped back season / year in terms of events and commitments for the body of St Marys. Maybe with emotional and spiritual healing events and programmes led by outsiders.

I believe the Lord gave me a prophetic picture tonight which started as you were introducing the evening.

I saw a trickle of a stream running through an incredibly dry, hot and rocky landscape. In the picture I was following this trickle heading upstream in the direction it was coming from. Eventually I reached a place where there was a huge amount of boulders and rubble blocking what was supposed to be a large river and all that was getting through was this small trickle. I wondered what this meant but did not have an interpretation until near the end of our time together.

Towards the end of our meeting I realised that the rubble were all sorts of things in the lives of us who make up St Mary's but the pile was so huge that it was impossible for us to deal with and sort out. I was then reminded of Nicola Neal's vision of the dry bones in Ezekiel and it was the same vision - the Lord was asking in this context - can this rubble be moved? Our response needs to be the same as Ezekiel: "Sovereign Lord only you know." And his answer to us is to prophesy over this rubble that the Lord will remove it, bring healing, reconciliation, conviction, repentance, holiness and righteousness in our lives so that the river will flow again.

It seems to me that in our times of prayer, he is calling us to persist in taking spiritual authority through prayer over the blockages in the name of Jesus and he will respond and do the heavy lifting as we are on our knees.

To St Mary's:

There is a repositioning of people within and there's a leaning out, a repositioning of people out and there's almost a new team's coming, a new shaping of teams in this hour and it's not dependant on training and it's not dependant on how we've understood things to look in the past it's actually, you know, the place and space that you're meant to step into and it's through prayer, through the prophetic and through seeking his face, through intimacy that you'll know where each one of you will know where to stand.

The children are really critical to what's coming. I'm increasingly seeing myself - I'm helping my daughter to drive at the moment..... I am having to sit in the seat next to her as she drives and just give her the freedom to drive but be right there by her side to nurture, to encourage, to press the brake.... and I think that's really important. I was in a church last week and I hardly saw the leaders at all but I saw the young and I thought the leaders were very present, they were nurturing what God was doing, they were mothering and they were fathering but they were releasing the young ... mainly students that I'm talking about... but it can be any age but I think there's this sense of a release of the young in order to drive certain things with that parenting nurturing training arms around it.

Just as Malcolm and I were walking in I felt something around giving as well. There's something the Lord wants to do in terms of our giving where .. it's like a release, you know how you feel a release when you worship the Lord and you feel that sense of his presence, there's a release when we give and it's like a sowing into what you believe you can see coming.. through this place and through each one of you and going: "We are behind what God is doing and we want to see more." We're so careful to be good stewards but we can miss this generous generosity of God who wants to pour out, open the floodgates... it's all his anyway right? We just give it back to him and we say "Lord do with it whatever you want to do but we trust you Lord and we release it into your hands!"

Summary of the words shared

1. “It’s Time” — A Coming Move of God

Many of the images (the golden clock, the wave paused in the distance, the flood of living water) point to a sense that **God is about to act in a significant way**. This move is described as imminent, powerful, and transformative. The repeated question “*Do you not perceive it?*” underlines urgency and attentiveness.

2. Preparation, Purification, and Surrender

A major emphasis is that God’s people must **prepare themselves spiritually**. This preparation includes:

- Removing obstacles, idols, distractions
- Allowing God to “strip away,” heal, refine, purify
- Laying down personal plans
- Returning to “first love” devotion
- Making room for the Holy Spirit
- Becoming “new wineskins”

The imagery of decorating a room, fire consuming the church, and new pure growth emerging all highlight **refinement before revival**.

3. Costly Obedience and Discomfort

The expected move of God is described as both **glorious and uncomfortable**. Preparation may require:

- Sacrifice of time, plans, and routines
- Intercession, worship, and obedience beyond convenience
- Sharing in the sufferings of Christ
- Emotional burden for the broken world

- Being stretched or repositioned

The message stresses that revival is beautiful but also deeply costly.

4. Reordering, Releasing, and Repositioning of People

Several images speak of **separation, reassignment, and raising up new people:**

- A dividing field representing readiness vs. unreadiness
- Younger or newer believers overtaking older ones due to hunger and purity of heart
- Repositioning of teams and leadership
- A release of children and young people to take significant roles
- Leaders becoming more like nurturing mothers and fathers

This theme highlights a **restructuring within the church** to align with what God is doing.

5. Outpouring of the Holy Spirit — A Wave, Wind, and Flood

Powerful metaphors of the Spirit recur throughout:

- A tsunami of the Holy Spirit
- A rushing wind (Acts 2)
- Fire from the throne
- Living water turning from trickles into floods

This outpouring is described as cleansing, overwhelming, transformative, and nation-shaping.

God is about to move powerfully, but His people must prepare deeply, surrender fully, reorder their lives, and make room for a costly yet glorious outpouring of His Spirit.
